This project provided targeted advisory services to increase the energy efficiency of micro-, small and medium-sized enterprises in Ukraine. Experienced executives and senior managers from developed countries advised the management of selected companies in Ukraine which have high potential for energy savings. The aim was to help Ukrainian managers identifying energy-saving potential within the respective company and to raise awareness on the economic advantages of introducing energy-efficient technologies and materials.

- Project completed
- EBRD has provided consultancy services to Ukrainian companies, carrying out various energy efficiency audits. Specific investment measures are currently being implemented or planned in seven companies.
- EBRD has carried out energy efficiency seminars in Ukraine. Another expert seminar is being planned.
