AFRICAN COP: FROM THE PERSPECTIVE OF GERMANY'S INTERNATIONAL CLIMATE INITIATIVE (ICI)

The German Government has been cooperating with African countries for a number of decades, and has in recent years placed growing emphasis on collaborating with African partners in the field of climate change adaptation and mitigation.

The side event promotes exchange of experiences on priority themes such as climate-friendly technologies (example South Africa) and specific adaptation needs (example Mali).
