The Federal Environment Ministry calls for ideas for two bilateral programmes with India. The Call is part of IKI's country-specific selection procedure. A total of EUR 35 million is available for the selection procedure. The ideas competition will be coordinated and implemented by the IKI Secretariat. Programme outlines can be submitted from now until 4 November 2019. The earliest start of programmes can be expected from the beginning of 2021.


