The 21st Conference of Parties to the UN Framework Convention on Climate Change (UNFCCC) (COP21) will take place from November 30 to December 11, 2015 in Paris. As in previous years, The International Climate Initiative (IKI) of the German Federal Ministry for the Environment, Nature Conservation, Building and Nuclear Safety (BMUB) will take part in the climate conference in Paris. IKI has been financing climate and biodiversity projects in developing, newly industrialising countries and in the transition countries since 2008. The IKI supports efforts towards a comprehensive global climate agreement, forms part of the German climate financing, and fosters synergies between climate protection and biodiversity conservation. 




