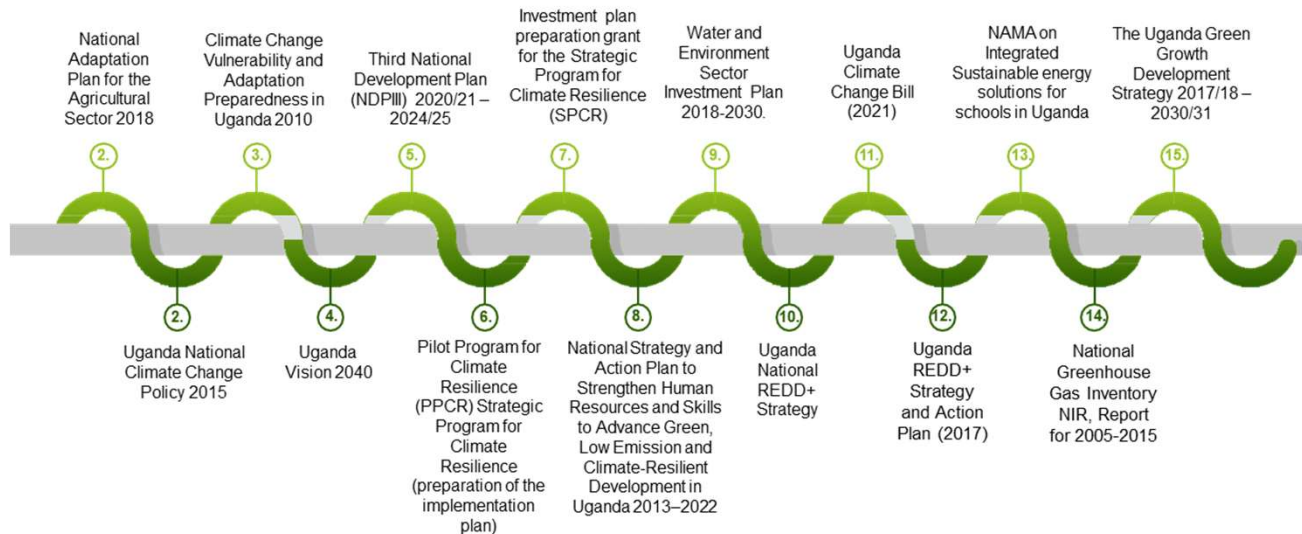

Why Uganda's updated NDC

- Uganda's climate change landscape and situation has changed since the country submitted its last NDC in 2015, hence the need for an updated NDC to ensure that Uganda's NDC remains relevant, implementable and in line with latest national policies.
- Among others, Uganda's updated NDC takes into account the following latest developments:



Process undertaken to update the NDC – 6 Steps

2. Situational Assessments

- Life-cycle consumption and production assessment to identify Uganda's areas of priority for the updated NDC
- **Completed – Dec 2020**

4. NDC Revision

- Draft updated NDC, including
- Enhanced mitigation and adaptation targets
- New NDC sectors and targets
- Cost-benefit analysis of actions
- NDC finance strategy

6. NDC Finalization

- Finalize updated NDC
- Develop NDC communication package

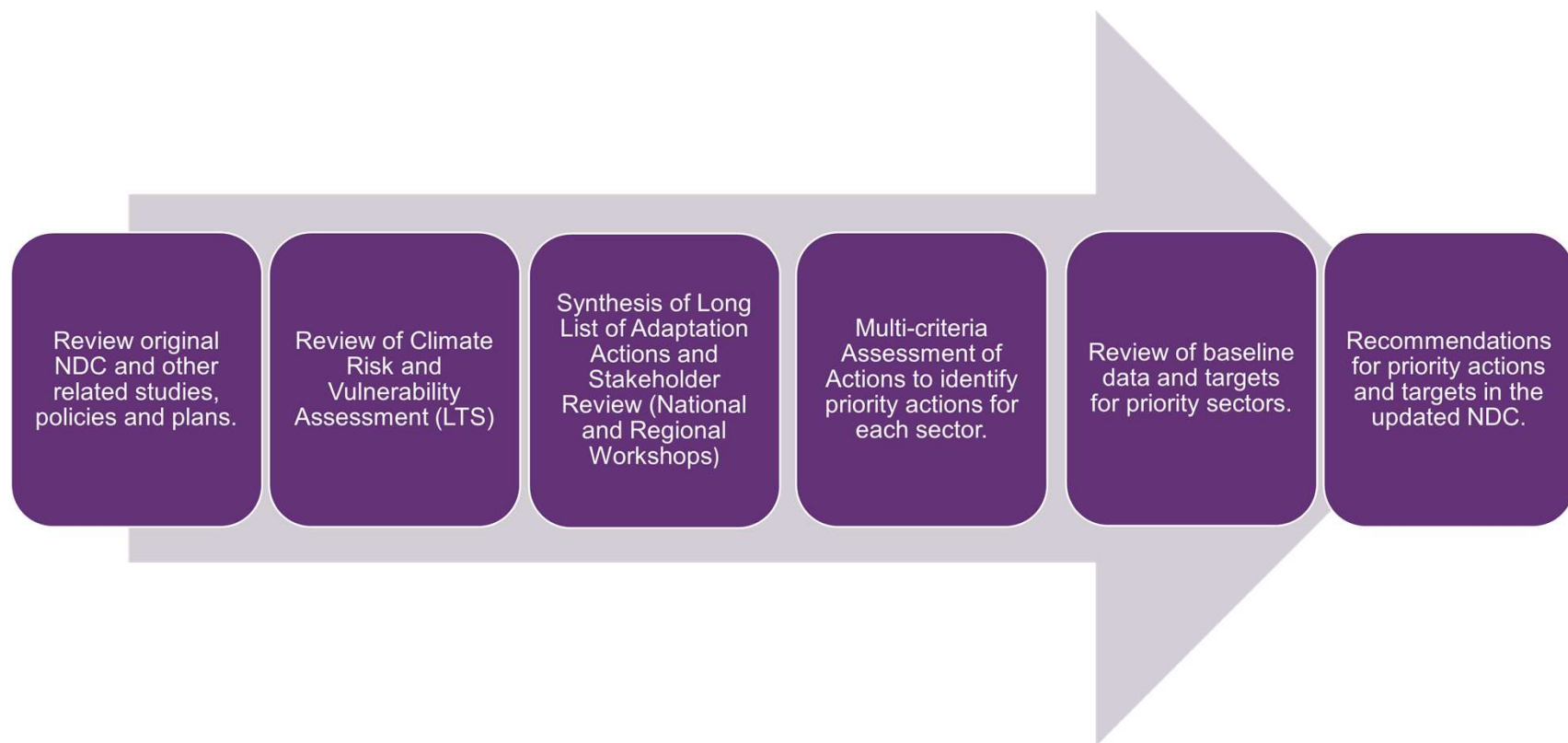

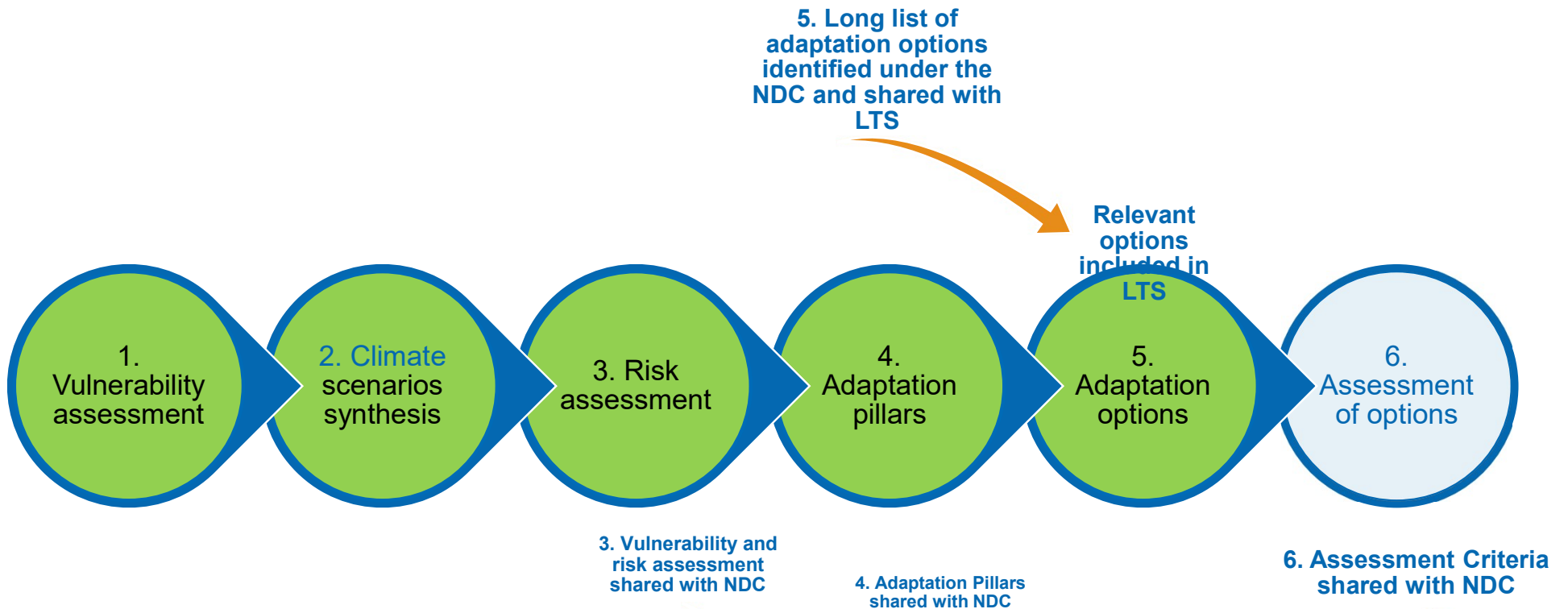

Adaptation actions identified by the NDC and shared with LTS.

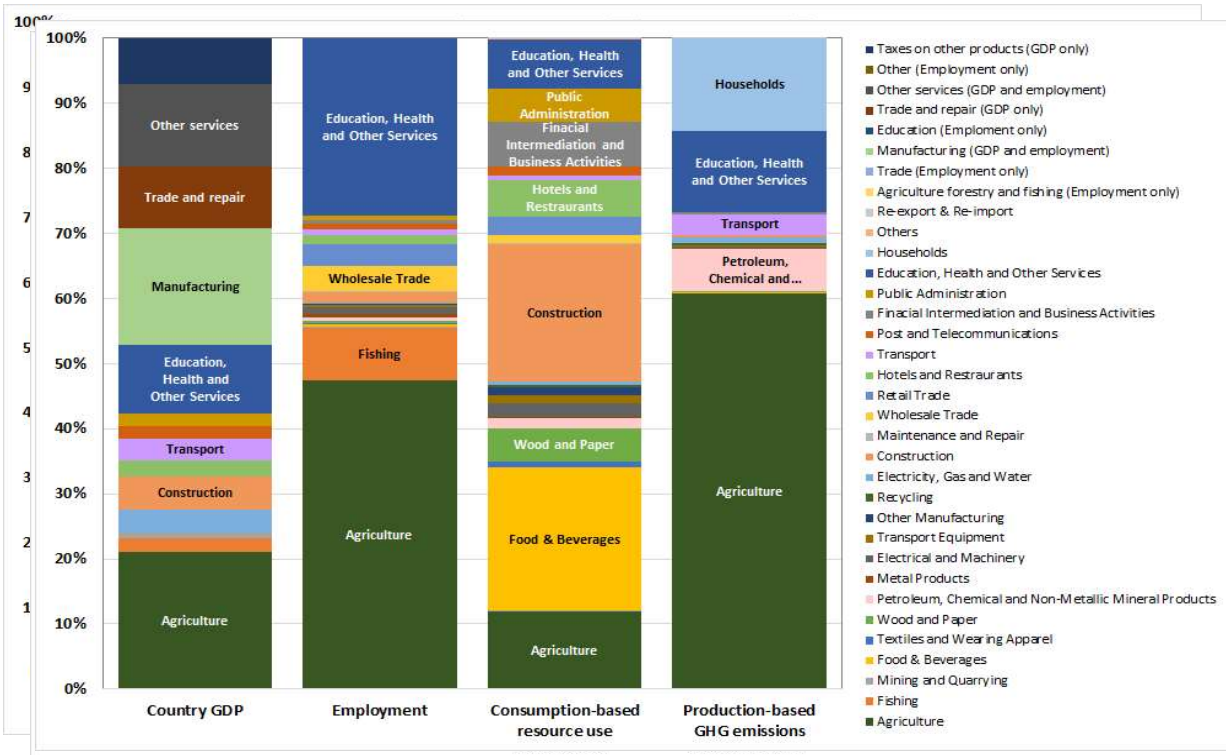
Used to identify priority sectors for the NDC.

Approach to mitigation assessment and NDC targets

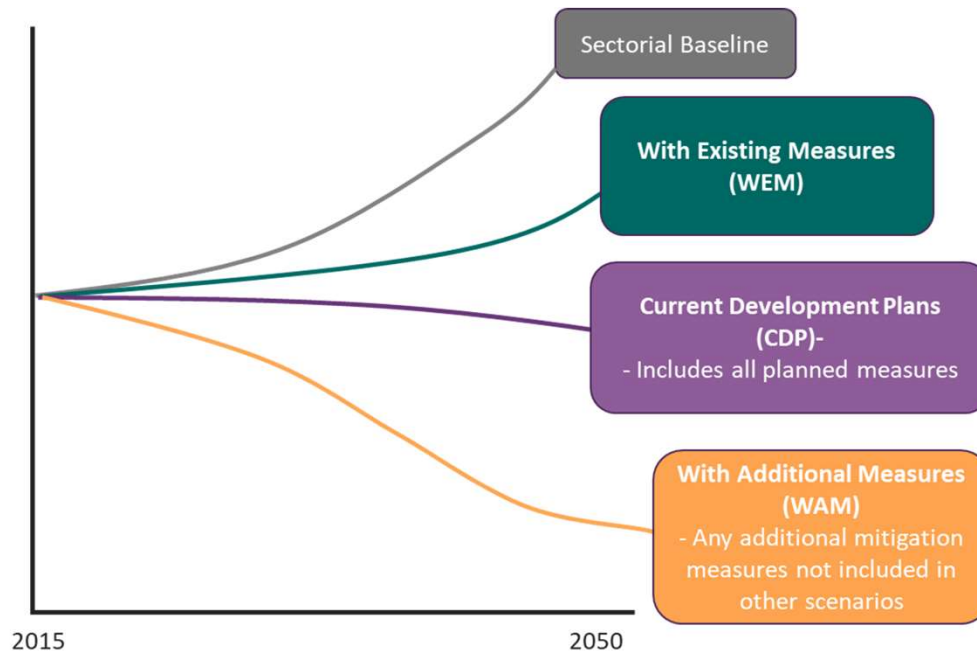
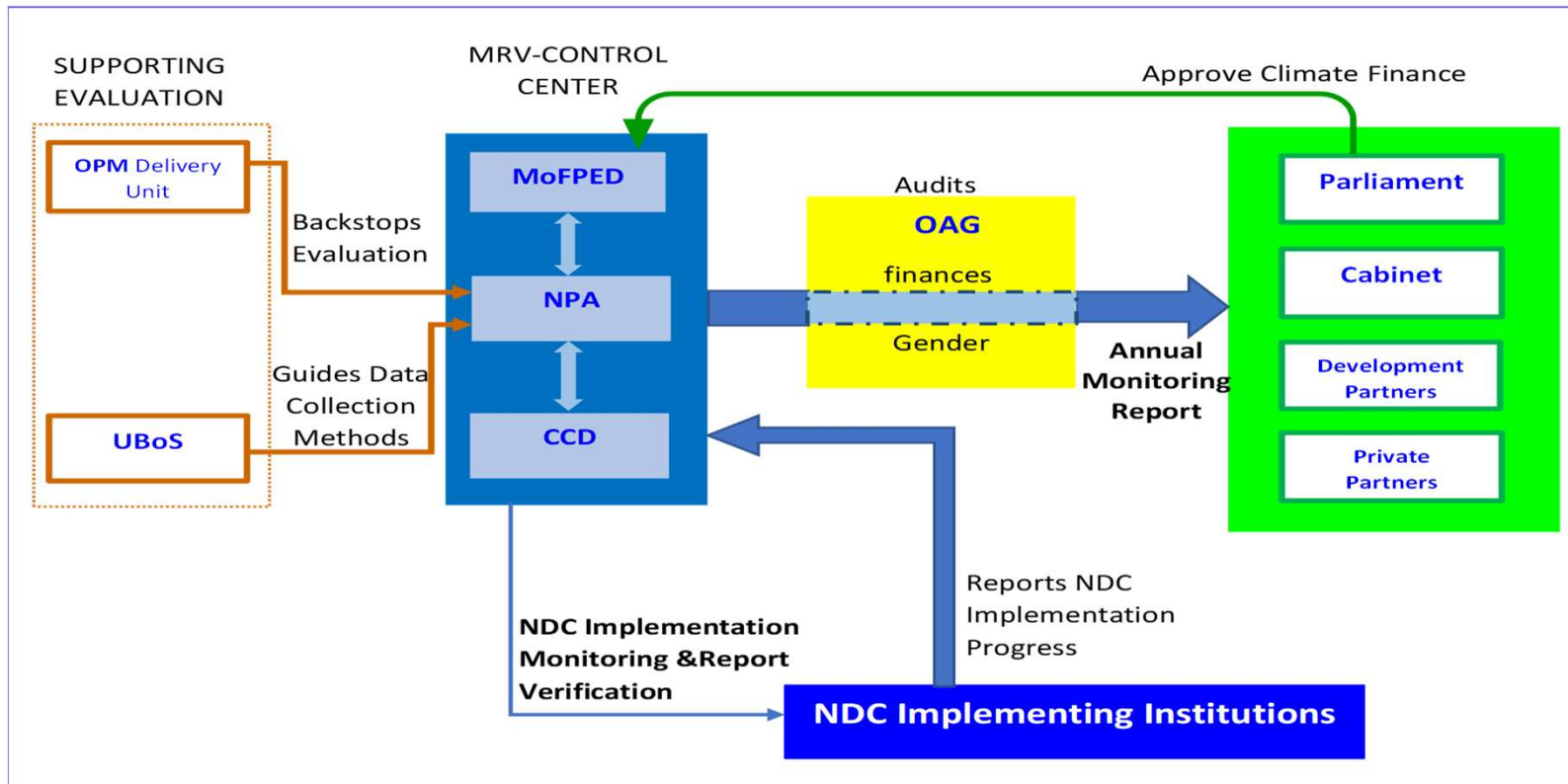


Figure 1: Sectorial scenarios to be modelled.

Key issues:

- **Baseline definition:** This needs to be finalized in consultation with the CCD and Climate Change Committee
- **Mitigation Actions:** To be finalized after Stakeholder consultations – It is expected that additional ones will come from stakeholders
- **Multi-Criteria Assessment:** Criteria and Weighting to be finalized by the CCD and Climate Change Committee with inputs from stakeholder workshops

Institutional structure- NDC implementation





NDC Implementation and Resource mobilization strategy

Resource Mobilization; aimed to search and acquire the requisite volumes of climate-related finance capital for the implementation of various activities that contribute towards achieving the goals set in the updated NDC.

Climate finance is sought from different sources which may differ in their funding requirements and modalities of the finance that they issue.

- Improved data and MRV system for reporting and tracking on NDC targets
- Resource mobilization areas developed on NDC implementation (5 concept notes developed so far)
- Development of the framework for carbon markets (article 6 Paris Agreement and Voluntary Carbon market)
