Country specific requests for proposals

The International Climate Initiative (IKI) is currently running a call for proposals for programmes that implement climate and biodiversity activities in Argentina, Costa Rica and Ukraine. The call targets integrated large-scale programmes with a funding volume between EUR 12,5 million to EUR 35 million and a duration of up to seven years. The call will run till 29 April 2019.
