## **IKI Small Grants launches 3rd Call for Proposals**

Just in time for the festive season in many countries, IKI Small Grants are launching a new funding opportunity. From funding electric bicycles in Kenya to supporting wetland restoration in Colombia, IKI Small Grants directly addresses local actors. The programme aims to support ideas that contribute to mitigating greenhouse gas emissions, adapting to the impacts of climate change and conserving forests and biodiversity worldwide, while helping implementers build and expand their capacities and networks. In the current call for proposals, the IKI explicitly encourages applications that refer to the UN Decade for Ecosystem Restoration, promote gender equality and/or involve youth.
